LOCAL LAW #1-2005

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF DELANSON, NEW YORK  
RELATING TO WATER COMMISSION AND TAP-IN FEES

**Be it enacted** by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Delanson as follows:

SECTION 1. Village Ordinance Regulating Use of Water Facilities and Providing for Water Rents adopted September 17, 1955, Sections 8 and 9 are replaced as follows:

SECTION 8. Tapping the Mains.

The Village shall install service lines from the main, to and including the curb box, unless otherwise authorized by the Water Commissioner. The property owner, at its expense shall be responsible for the installation of service lines from the curb box to premises. The size and type of installation shall be determined by the Water Commissioner. A fee for the inspection of the connection at the curb box may be established by the Board of Trustees by resolution from time to time.

SECTION 9. Payment For Tapping the Mains.

The property owner shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred by the Village in making the tap-in to the water main, laying service to the curb box and installation of the curb box. Payment to the Village shall be made prior to Commencement of service.

SECTION 2. This local law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
