- 1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE LEAD BY MAYOR GIFFORD
- 2. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 7:02 P.M.

ALL PRESENT: Mayor Gifford, Trustee O'Connor Trustee Grenier, Chief Morrison, Water Commissioner Iveson, Clerk Mormando, Ron Holbrook, Sally Burns

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Regular Meeting June 8, 2015 Special Meeting for Fiscal Year review May 29, 2015

MOTION TO ACCEPT: Trustee O'Connor 2ndTrustee Grenier

4. REPORTS:

A. FIRE DEPARTMENT: 13 Calls, fairly busy, Re-Did the election 1st Asst Chief - Duane Rapp, 2nd Asst. Chief - Lori Buccino, Captain – Charles Buccino, The fire department received a \$54,000 grant for air packs. There may be a slight difference between the amount of the air packs and the grant. Representative from Scott Airpacks is coming to perform a demonstration. Mayor Gifford asked the treasurer to see if we have extra money to cover the difference. Chief Morrison is working on a grant for a system for the hall. The bylaws have been approved and he will get the board a copy. Mayor Gifford says the rec room looks great after the fire dept cleaned it up. Mayor asks about training for Heroin over dose, Chief Morrison says the ambulance folks may have this. Mayor Gifford asks about the spare fridge, Kevin says it was just the outlet and the fridge works fine. Chief says he topped off a residents pool, owner is an electrician and will come and look at our outlet issue. Mayor will call Dayton, insurance rep with question about fire.

- B. TREASURER/CLERK: Reports submitted. Dividend check from Nymar for 99.28. Ron Holbrook asks to review the report (Trial Balance)
- C. WATER DEPARTMENT: report submitted. Iveson spoke with Dig Safely. ME engineering needs to replace ... Mayor asks if Dante called him to check the meter. Multi-service valve ordered from Jager, waiting for quote from them. Macmillan Well, Francois feels it needs to be completely redone. Iveson will take measurements and photos for upper reservoir. If it's not minimum 10 feet, it will be a very large project (a major rebuild). Brief discussion about measurements. Trustee Grenier asks about eliminating the MacMillan well entirely. Brief discussion about eliminating the well. Mayor Gifford will order 4 signs to post at the reservoirs. Mayor wants to keep the trimmer at the gate.

Mayor asks about the Sanitary Survey, has it been received...no. Thank you to Ron for trying to remove the notice about the res from Hook n Bullet about fishing at the res.

- D. PLANNING BOARD: Not meeting in August. Will meet on the 2nd Monday in Sept.
- E. ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: Did not meet
- F. PUBLIC WORKS: Poles removed from Thousand acre road, Mayor will talk to Bill Reid about putting that out to bid. Street sweeping is done. Mowing to be done through Village in the next 2-3 weeks. DOT specs for road patch on 395 are very extreme and very expensive. Trustee O'Connor suggests we send out an RFP with the specs. He will call Kent. Go out to bid for Thousand Acre Road too. Storm drains for Thousand Acre Road should be included in that RFP. Perhaps the town will finish it?! Mayor Gifford will call Bill.
- G. BUILDING INSPECTOR: Met with Bruce (Postmaster), Dale Warner & ?. The post Office is falling apart. The pavement is sinking too. Parking lot will be dug up, drainage installed. 2 prices -1 for replacement and one for restoring it. Building permit issued by Dale.
- H. ANIMAL CONTROL: Report submitted. Submitted a voucher to the Town for reimbursement. Fox are out in the Village.

Trustee O'Connor will help look through the easements in our safe. The rep mentioned a place called NRCS. They will come and complete our FEMA projects for free. Mayor has a call into Francois.
