1. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE LEAD BY MAYOR GIFFORD

2. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 7:01 P.M.

ALL PRESENT: Mayor Gifford, Trustee O'Connor (excused), Trustee Grenier, Chief Morrison (forgot), Water Commissioner Iveson, Clerk Mormando, Bill Wilkey

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES SEPTEMBER 14, 2015

MOTION TO ACCEPT: Tabled

4. REPORTS:

A. FIRE DEPARTMENT: 10 calls for the month. Chief Morrison is talking with Santa Barbara about foam trailers in case of derailment and a derailment drill. Next breakfast in November 1st. Continuing with food pantry donations.

B. TREASURER/CLERK: Annual report has been filed. Clerk needs to put notice in the paper.

C. WATER DEPARTMENT: Belamos says we owe a bill for returned parts that didn't work. Jeff spoke with someone who said our account has been credited. Discussion about the 'chopshop' on Railroad Ave. Call from DEC, wants to meet Iveson to inspect the dam at the lower reservoir tomorrow at 11:30AM. Mayor Gifford will try to be there. Iveson suggests finding the paperwork that shows we cut down the brush (that is now overgrown again). Still hasn't received his SLACK order. The zinc is depleted. Iveson will call them again tomorrow. Jeff did the mark-out at Loftfield's pole barn.

D. PLANNING BOARD: Meeting tonight. Submitted their minutes. Bruce Barton has been a big help with updating the laws. Mary McGloughlin is resigning. Some discussion of the Railroad Ave project. Now the project is changing to a body shop and possible apartment building.

E. ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS: Did not meet

F. PUBLIC WORKS: DOT will be putting up school advisory signs. The state will be putting up the speed zone on 395. Mayor Gifford spoke with Kent at DOT about the storm drain that Trustee Grenier brought up last meeting.

Set up special (no emergency) meeting....date and reason....so we can discuss quotes with Josh (who is excused) and award projects to a contractor.

Discussion about several locations (Ionic Labs, Harvest Homes, Basset Healthcare, Demarco Funeral Home) that are not in compliance with their water. The Health Department saw this on Commissioner Iveson's report.
