

### Spring Brush and Leaf Pick-Up

The annual Village-wide brush and leaf pick up is scheduled for May 8<sup>th</sup>. Leaves must be contained in bio-degradable paper bags. Tree branches should be left in large pieces no bigger than 8 inches in diameter and should be at least 4 feet in length and not heavier than 40 lbs. Put the cut ends toward the roadside. Christmas trees are included! Please place brush and leaf bags by the side of the road to be picked up by the Duanesburg Highway Department on May 8<sup>th</sup>. This service is provided as a courtesy and is meant to clean up winter kill and debris only. Thank you for your consideration.

Garbage pickup for Village residents is normally every Wednesday beginning at 7:30am. Recycle bins and trash cans in 2 sizes are provided to residents at no cost. It is recommended that customers use the specially designed cans that roll and connect to the truck saving the crew from possible neck and back injury. Receptacles are the property of Pollard and may be replaced at a cost borne by the resident if damaged. Trash collection is limited to household trash only. Residents with large items or an excessive amount of trash are asked to contact Pollard prior to collection day as alternate arrangements and fees may apply.
