518-Area Code

Get ready to change the way you dial your calls made within the 518area code! Don't forget as of August 19, you will have to dial a 518 in front of all phone numbers (cell or landline) in the 518-area code. Here's why:

Area Code Overlay Approved for the New York 518 Area Code

To ensure a continuing supply of telephone numbers, the new 838 area code will be added to the area served by 518. This is known as an area code overlay.

What is an area code overlay?

An overlay is the addition of another area code (838) to the same geographic region as an



existing area code (518). An overlay does not require customers to change their existing area code.

Who will be affected?

The 518-area code covers all or part of 17 counties in eastern upstate New York, serving communities in the Capital region of Albany and its surrounding suburbs, such as Plattsburgh and Lake Placid. The new 838 area code will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 518 area

What will be the new dialing procedure?

To complete calls within the 51. area code region, the new dialing procedure requires callers to dial

area code + telephone number.

This means that all calls in the 518area code that are currently dialed with seven digits will need to be dialed using ten digits, that is, the area code + telephone number. The same dialing procedure will apply to telephone numbers

assigned to the new 838 area code.

When will the change begin?

Beginning August 19, you must use the new dialing procedures, as described above for all calls. After this date, if you do not use the new dialing procedures, your calls will not be completed and a recording will instruct you to hang up and dial again.

Hydrant Flushing

November 11 between 7:00AM - 4:30PM

Flushing will be performed on Saturday, November 11 from 7:00am - 4:30pm. Please avoid doing laundry during this time, and expect water discoloration for a period of 24 hours. Be sure to have plenty of bottled water on hand for drinking and cooking.

Water Rents

Water rents are billed quarterly in July, October, January and April.

- 1st Quarter July through September due without penalty during July;
- 2nd Quarter October through December due without penalty during October;
- 3rd Quarter January through March due without penalty during January;
- 4th Quarter April June due without penalty during April.
 Unpaid water rents for all Village Residents are re-levied May 15 annually to Village Tax.

Email Notification System

The Village of Delanson has initiated a new email notification system whereby residents can be notified by email immediately of important information or any emergency situation that has developed in the Village. Examples would be water main breaks, water main repairs, hydrant flushing, sudden changes in Village services such as garbage pickup or snow plowing, flooding, road closings, damaged roads etc. Emails will not be sent for normal news items, notices or scheduled events. In addition, updates will be emailed to keep residents

informed of the ongoing circumstances as new information is received by the Village, until the event or emergency is over.

There is no cost for this service. Simply fill in your name and email address in the box on the lower left sidebar of the website (Delanson.net) home page and click the SUBSCRIBE button. You will receive an email asking you to confirm your decision to receive these bulletins. Once we receive your confirmation, you will be added

to our mailing list to receive theses notices.

Your privacy is important to us, so your email address will not be shared, sold or used in any other capacity. You may unsubscribe, at any time, by clicking on the unsubscribe link on any email you receive or by contacting the web guy at at

Complaints of Jdling Trains

It is prohibited by <u>Local Law 2-1990</u> for trains to idle within the Village limits for more than 30 minutes. Complaints of trains idling for prolonged periods of time should be directed to the **Norfork Southern Railway**. For a thorough investigation of the incident, the following facts must be presented at the time of the complaint.

- Date the train was idling in the Village;
- **Time** of day the train came into Village, left the Village and the length of time you observed the train idling in Village;
- Nearest Crossing Location Main street # 250195D or Cole Road # 250074F The phone number for idling trains is 1-800-453-2530

FORMAL COMPLAINTS – Superintendents Office – 1-717-541-2100

You can also call this emergency number for trains blocking the road, people climbing on the train, ATV activity on the access road, etc. Calling the State Police will trigger a call to Norfork Southern Emergency as well, the State Police may be able to respond faster in certain situations.

Keep a list of all the dates and times you have called to complain about the train. This information can then be gathered by Mayor Gifford and sent to Federal & State agencies that may assist us in prohibiting the trains from idling in the Village.

Pollard Disposal 2017 Holiday Pickup Schedule

As most residents are aware, garbage pickup is delayed by one day as a result of certain holidays. Garbage is normally picked up every Wednesday starting at 7:00 AM in the Village of Delanson. However, the week of the following holidays, garbage collection will be delayed by one day and picked up on Thursdays instead of Wednesdays.

Week of Labor Day, September 4th - garbage will be picked up on Thursday September 7th, 2017 Week of Christmas, December 25th - garbage will be picked up on Thursday December 28th, 2017 There are no changes to other Holidays.

No Open Burning in Delanson

It is prohibited, at all times, to burn garbage, trash, leaves, yard waste, or yard debris. Burn barrels or free-standing fires are also prohibited in the Village.

- The emissions of an open fire may not interfere with the reasonable enjoyment or quality of life or property or create a smoke or odor nuisance to a neighboring property.
- Open fires must be a safe distance from any structure, building, property line or trees, brush or shrubs.



• Open fires may be fueled only by paper, paper products (such as cardboard), unadulterated wood, lumber and charcoal.

Open burning is the single greatest cause of wildfires in New York. Dry conditions and the close proximity of homes in the Village makes open burning extremely dangerous. Smoke from open fires can be overbearing and unhealthy for neighbors. Please be smart and considerate of yourself, your neighbors and the law.

To report an illegal open fire or a nuisance fire, you can call the DEC hotline at 1-844-332-3267 or the local fire department. The Fire Department has the authority to extinguish or order extinguished any open fire being conducted in violation of any provision of our local Open Burn Law.
