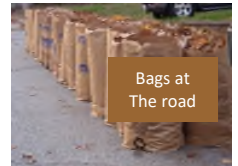

Leaf and Brush Pick-Up***May 24th***

The annual Village-wide brush pick up is scheduled for May 24th. Leaves must be contained in bio-degradable paper bags.

PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE!! LEAF BAGS CONTAINING DOG FECES WILL BE REFUSED!!

Tree branches should be no bigger than 8" in diameter and left in large pieces at the road. The longer lengths you leave the branches, the safer it is for the workers to feed them into the chipper. Please place brush and leaf bags by the side of the road to be picked up by the Duanesburg Highway Department on **Monday the 24th**.

The following is a schedule of the days the water mains and hydrants will be flushed. Residents will be notified if there is a change in this schedule. All hydrant flushing's will occur on Saturdays between the hours of 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM, weather permitting. Please mark these days on your calendar.

- November 13, 2021

It is recommended that you have bottled water available for drinking and cooking. We also advise you have several buckets of water available for flushing toilets and washing hands. We don't recommend doing laundry at this time since the water could be brown and stain your laundry.

In addition, during the winter months, residents with hydrants on their property are asked to clear the hydrants of snow, if possible, so the hydrants can be found by the fire department in case of a fire in the area.
