A. FIRE DEPARTMENT:

December – 12 calls, 7 were EMS, 2 fire alarms, 1 MVA, 1 mutual aid, missed 3 calls. 128 total calls – missed 25 (19.5% miss rate). Some of this is due to being on the ambulance.

Imagetrend is up and running so we will have better reporting.

\$3000 grant; \$1500 DEC matching – will be used for hose, helmets and nozzles.

Based on water usage, Water Commissioner Iveson believes there is still a break. Still hearing a lot of water over there on Stewart and can see water in the sewer main. Water Commissioner Iveson is trying to get the Sewer Department to come with a camera to see if he can see where the leak is from there. Discussion regarding other further steps that will be taken to determine where the leak is.

Double B fixed the electrical issues at the Water Plant. Water Commissioner Iveson can now change out the chlorine injection pump now that is fixed.
