4. REPORTS:

- A. FIRE DEPARTMENT: Assistant Chief Aidan Enders submitted his report. They received a \$2000 Fire Improvement grant from Schenectady County. The Company passed a resolution to adopt the newly created bylaws that are more specific to officer compliance and attendance and presented a copy to the Village Board. Fire will hire a Grant Writer @ \$10,000, Village Board previously agreed to pay 50%. Discussion ongoing necessary engine & tanker repairs and the need for a new vehicle. Discussion on funding and piggybacking off Franklin County contract with DeNooyer for \$76,000 for a new pickup truck. Quotes and specs submitted. Mayor Gifford will discuss this with Lydia & Nicole. Aidan presented 3 quotes for UTV trailer and plans to use Capital reserve funds to purchase. Discussion of same. Trustee O'Connor thanked Aidan for his thorough research and ongoing efforts to better the company. He reiterated the importance and oversight of ALL officers' compliance of bylaws and being present.

Jeff informed them the pilot study was now online. Jeff indicated all the recommendations from State DOH were financially burdensome. We need to talk to Jasan/EPA about additional funding for improvements. Hydrant flushing was cut short because he almost ran out of water. Jeff & Nick cleaned up the plant & grounds and fixed all the issues the culvert project contractors left. Nick needs to complete his licensing.
